ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT— MARVIN MACHARIA, TRANSFERRED TO CSUSB



Please tell me a little bit about yourself?

I am an undergraduate student at CSUSB my major is biology. I graduated from Barstow Community College and Barstow High School. I play soccer as often as I can, and I enjoy talking to new people and seeing the world through their eyes.

Why did you choose to transfer to CSUSB?

I absolutely enjoyed the campus tour I got and felt comfortable being here.

What is your favorite thing about CSUSB?

I love the people there, all absolutely caring just take your time to know them.

Is there anything that you wish you would have known before going to CSUSB that you didn't find out about until after the fact?

I am a pre-med student and one of the things I wish I knew is that my journey effectively starts from the first day of community college. Barstow provides the best opportunity at interacting with a medically underserved population and really getting a first hand account of the challenges that affect this community. I would urge pre-med students to understand these challenges by getting involved in the community and using those experiences to grow.

Do you feel that you have been challenged in your coursework at CSUSB ?

Being in a quarter system is definitely a big challenge. Classes are more fast paced and your professors expect a certain level of seriousness when attending the class and as a result will not push you to complete your assignments. That being said, it is not impossible to do exceptionally well. However, you have to approach your classes with a different mindset than you had in community college. I urge you to find your purpose, find like minded individuals, and I guarantee the journey will be very enjoyable.

Do you feel that the professors and the college staff are helpful and approachable?

Yes! The summer before I began my classes, I was able to meet with the head of my majors department and discuss my college plan within an hour of emailing him. Staff and professors are helpful and approachable, however, you have to make the conscious effort to approach them, find out the type of research they are involved in, and build a rapport. It is not hard to get to know them and get involved in their research. The sad bit is that most students will not take the time to do this.

What kind of advice would you offer to a BCC student looking to transfer to CSUSB?

Be willing to listen and learn from both your peers and upper classmen. There is a lot to learn about selecting classes, choosing a career path, and realizing your goals that I believe can only be learned through interacting with your fellow students. I have been fortunate to find wonderful role models and mentors and I would not think twice about offering the same level of assistance to an incoming student.
