

Responding to On-Campus Immigration Enforcement Activities

1.

NOTIFY the Office of the President immediately if you are aware of immigration law enforcement activities on campus. If the Office of the President is closed, contact On-Campus Security.

No employee outside of the Office of the President is authorized to accept legal documents from immigration enforcement officers.

2.

DOCUMENT and provide the Office of the President or Campus Security with all the details of immigration enforcement activities as soon as possible.

Include time, location, officer name/credential, and details of officer's request, if known.

3.

ESCORT officers to the Office of the President.

If you do not feel comfortable escorting officers, contact Campus Security to assist.

You may not give consent for an immigration officer to enter any non-public area of campus (e.g. classrooms, office areas, etc.)

4.
